

GUIDE FOR CONTRIBUTORS

Content:

Articles for *New Associations* are usually either 1,000 or 2,000 words. The specific limit will be agreed between you and your Editorial Board contact. We respectfully ask contributors to keep to the agreed word limit. Submissions over the limit will be returned for editing or edited in-house.

Whilst very limited clinical material may be used to illustrate a wider argument, please keep it to a minimum.

References should be minimal and for quotes or statistics only and should follow the Harvard system.

Accuracy:

Your article will be proofread, but please ensure names are spelt correctly and any facts are accurate.

By submitting your article, you agree that content is correct to the best of your knowledge.

Information to include with your submission:

- Article title
- Name you would like to be published under
- Biography, 40-word max
- Optional email and/or Twitter handle if you would like our readership to contact you
- High resolution head shot for use with your article

Once production has been completed, all contributors will be posted a copy of *New Associations*.
